 1. Overall lack of resources
 2. Access of information (centralized)
 3. Human resources (institutionalized)
 4. Varying articulations of R.O.I. (need centralized information)
 5. Building New Hope has internships & volunteer opportunities in Nicaragua, but need to find Spanish speaking students who can also afford the trip
 - B. Policy
 1. Policy/Political Will
 - a) Pittsburgh lags behind U.S.
 - b) U.S. lags behind world
 2. Global Education needs to be embedded into policy/systems structure
 - C. Equity
 1. Equity-poverty challenge
 2. Increasing access
 - a) global education experience is only for privileged few
 - (1) Costs, opportunity, time, etc.
 3. Marginalization
 - a) Access to opportunities
 - b) Language loss
 - D. Cost
 1. Funding
 - a) Programming
 - b) Professional development
 2. Finding interns/volunteers who can fund their own experience
 3. Money to get the experience
 - a) Transportation
 - b) Program cost
 - c) Other
 4. Financial constraints
 - a) To go abroad is expensive/cost prohibitive
 - b) To come here is expensive/cost prohibitive
 5. How to reach out to funders and show them that their global education makes a difference

1. K-12, higher education, study abroad, international students
2. Siloed education department
3. Institutional communities (silos)

F. Values

1. Lack of valuation of global education
 - a) Timing
 - b) Funding
2. Idea that its “for someone else”: not understanding importance FOR ALL
3. Because it’s seen as “extra” to people
 - a) Not seen as mandatory or critical
 - b) People don’t make time for it
 - (1) As stated before, resources are also not present
 - c) Seen as a luxury rather than an essential + valuable component of education
4. Keeping pace with an ever-changing world
 - a) Which makes education relevant
